



## THE 1 – 4 – 1 CALL

Structure of the Phone Call: (participants take turns to making and leading the call)

The intention of the 1-4-1 call is to encourage one another to embrace our God-given purpose as men, husbands, and fathers. It's a weekly brother to brother check-in. Our responsibility as men begins with our wives, our children, and those whom God has placed in our lives, and runs in parallel with an outward-oriented life. We encourage each other to be intentional in reaching out to others to fulfil the Great Commission of Christ.

The weekly call is meant to monitor each other's personal growth throughout our entire life spectrum.

This call is not a substitute for small group meetings in our churches, but to encourage one another to engage and support the vision and work of the local church, to "disperse more deeply" in the call to make disciples for Christ, to become an outward oriented people!

-The leader starts by verbally stating the purpose of the call, which is threefold:

- 1) We are in the gap as **intercessors** for one another.
- 2) **We care** about each other's families.
- 3) We **share the burden** with each other for the Great Commission in Matt 28.

### AGENDA POINTS TO HELP US MAKE CULTURE SHIFTS:

#### THE 4 CORE VALUES OF 4M:

**MODEL** – What is the Lord saying to us through His Word?

- Men are fountains. What's in our fountains?
- Let's help each other to model well! Phil: 3:17.

**We ask:** Who is imitating you? Do we hide behind feelings of inadequacy?

**MENTOR** - The Holy Spirit of God is the Counselor, the ultimate Mentor.

- Table of Support, meaningful and godly relationships in our lives to help us succeed.

**We ask:** Are we mentoring someone? Do we have mentors in our lives?

**MONITOR**- The value of weekly check-in 1-4-1 with each other.

- We pray for each other before every call, we come prepared!

**We ask:** How are we treating our wives?

How are we treating our children, and those whom God placed in our lives?

Are we living in repentance, forgiveness, and grace to others?

**MOVE ON** -The man of peace. Who is God laying upon our hearts?

**We ask:** Are we making disciples for Christ? We unite in prayer for the lost and needy.

Proverbs 11:30 (WEB) The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life. He who is wise wins souls.

Galatians 6:2 (WEB) Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

James 2:14 (WEB) What good is it, my brothers, if a man says he has faith, but has no works? Can faith save him?

**Ezekiel 34:6 (WEB) My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill: yes, my sheep were scattered on all the surface of the earth; and there was none who searched or sought.**
